Transfer Guidelines:

1. Resurrection University is an Illinois Articulation Initiative receiving institution. **Completed Associates of Arts degrees, Associates of Science degrees,** degrees meet all general education requirements for block transfer. If an AA or an AS Science degree has not been completed, courses will be transferred on a course by course basis. **Please note that a completed AAS or AGS will not meet all general education requirements for block transfer.**
2. Remedial/pre-college level courses, audit, credit, or proficiency scores are not transferrable.
3. Grades of 2.0 (C) or above on a 4.0 scale completed at regionally accredited colleges or universities are transferrable. Courses must be considered college level and have been used to fulfill graduation/degree requirements at the previous college or university.
4. A cumulative GPA and science GPA must be 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale and an overall TEAS exam score of a 68% or higher.
5. General education physical and life sciences, college math and social and behavioral sciences credits that have been fulfilled by nursing support course work may be substituted with general elective coursework.
6. †All Nursing Support Courses except for Lifespan Development are considered expired for the BSN-Pre-licensure program if taken more than 7 or more years prior to your intended start term.
