



Interprofessional Education Scholar Program with Micro-credential

The Interprofessional Education (IPE) Scholar Program at Resurrection University is comprised of a series of learning activities. These activities may include online lectures, discussions and other learning materials related to interprofessional education as well as the specialty area the student chooses to focus on. Students participating in the scholar program will be awarded digital badges for each portion of the program they complete, and will be awarded a micro-credential after completion of all six badges.

- Collaborate with fellow students in learning with, from and about their professions in a simulated learning environment

4 How do I complete the IPE Micro-credential program?

- Applications accepted twice per year
- Check for pre-requisites for your program
- Complete 5 online badges and 1 simulation badge
- After all 6 badges are complete, earn your complete micro-credential!

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What is a digital badge?

A digital badge is a new type of credential that allows you to show specific skills that you have gained through learning experiences. Micro-badges will be awarded for each of the six units in the IPE micro-credential courses. Learning is conducted via Discussion Boards, TED Talks, and videos. A micro-credential will be awarded after the completion of all six badges. The information about each badge is listed below:



1 Introduction to IPE

- Message from President Scanlan on the Importance of IPE at Resurrection University
- Overview of IPE history and the 4 competency domains: 1) Values and ethics 2) Roles and responsibilities 3) Communication 4) Teams and teamwork
- Learn Team STEPPS (Strategies and Tools to Enhance Performance and Patient Safety)
- Explore communication tools and crew management training used in the aviation industry videos
- View and comment on video from Martin Bromley a pilot from the UK who lost his wife due to poor communication in the operating room



4 Communication

- Explore interpersonal and communication skills
- Understand generational management
- Learn behaviors for success
- Improve difficult conversations
- Learn the importance of customer service



5 Teams and Teamwork

- Define teams
- Explore emotional intelligence
- Participate in a team project
- Listen to podcasts and participate in discussions on trust
- Engage in a CQI overview
- Provide personal reflections on team experiences



2 Values and Ethics

- Review case studies and discussions involving ethical dilemmas
- Explore and clarify values
- Review TED Talks on being present
- Write personal statements on values and ethics
- Learn about cultural engagement, cultural humility and cultural competence



6 Simulation

- Students will participate in scenarios related to a specialty area in a state-of-the-art simulated environment
- Students will be involved in skills lab related to their specialty micro-credential (e.g. perioperative scholars will have the chance to scrub, glove, gown and practice aseptic technique in an operating room environment)
- Students will be required to complete a ticket to entry and will learn about, from, and with other healthcare professionals in the simulated scenario



3 Roles and Responsibilities

- Discuss assumptions of healthcare workers' roles and responsibilities
- Clarify your role by uploading a personal video discussing your own roles
- Forge independent relationships with other professionals via discussion boards
- Learn about how other professionals complement your role
